Submission & Publication

The conference welcomes submissions of both original unpublished research (full paper or 1 page abstract) and published work (abstract only). Full paper submissions must be written in English, at most <u>ten (10)</u> pages long (including figures, tables, and references) and submitted in both a word and a PDF file. All full paper submissions will be peer reviewed. Only accepted full paper will be published in the conference proceedings after their presentations at the conference, which will be submitted for inclusion in **Scopus**.

The conference will organize the **best conference** and the **best student** paper competitions. Only full papers are qualified for the awards. The finalists selected by the award committee must present their work at the conference (on-side).
